

In compliance with the Certification and Agreement for HEERF II Funds of the CARES Act, below is information for TTUHSC

- An acknowledgement that the institution signed and returned to the Department the Certification and Agreement and the assurance that the institution has used, or intends to use, no less than 50 percent of the funds received under Section 18004(a)(1) of the CARES Act to provide Emergency Financial Aid Grants to students.
 - TTUHSC submitted the certification and agreement for Emergency Financial Aid Grants on April 22, 2020.
- TTUHSC has received **\$897,315**
- The total amount of Emergency Financial Aid Grants distributed to students under Section 18004(a)(1) of the CARES Act as of the date of submission (i.e., as of the 30-day Report and every 45 days thereafter).
- As of **3/31/2021, \$700,704** has been distributed to TTUHSC Students
- The estimated total number of students at the institution eligible to participate in programs under Section 484 in Title IV of the Higher Education Act of 1965 and thus eligible to receive Emergency Financial Aid Grants to students under Section 18004(a)(1) of the CARES Act.
 - TTUHSC Estimates that 3938 students were eligible to apply for CARES funding.
 - The total number of students who have received an Emergency Financial Aid Grant to students under Section 18004(a)(1) of the CARES Act.
 - As of **3/31/2021, 742** TTUHSC Students received funding
- The method(s) used by the institution to determine which students receive Emergency Financial Aid Grants and how much they would receive under Section 18004(a)(1) of the CARES Act.
- To be eligible for CARES funding at TTUHSC, students must meet the following criteria:
 - Enrolled during the spring 2021 term in an eligible academic program
 - Have filed a complete and/or verified 2020-2021 Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) so financial need could be determined.
