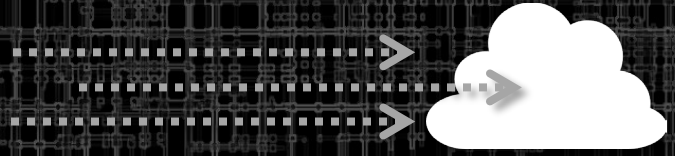


Don't Lose Your TTUHSC Data!

Store It Right



In case of an accident, a lockout, network shutdown, or cyberattack, data kept on approved TTUHSC IT networked storage systems is securely backed up and recoverable.

What are the advantages of using *approved storage solutions?*

As long as you are on a secure connection, you can access the data from anywhere

If your desktop/laptop is lost/stolen/damaged, that data, because it is stored on the network, is not affected

All of the protections IT provides for TTUHSC networks (encryption, firewalls, security tools, scans, regular redundant backups) are in place to protect that data
