Operating Policy and Procedure

SOM OP: 30.03, Electronic Devices in the Classroom

PURPOSE: The purpose of this School of Medicine (SOM) policy and procedure is

to inform students regarding the appropriate use of electronic devices in

classroom or other educational settings.

REVIEW: This SOM Policy and Procedure shall be reviewed within each even-

numbered fiscal year by the Curriculum and Educational Policy Committee.

Revisions will be forwarded to the Office of the Dean for publication.

POLICY/PROCEDURE:

1. General. This policy is intended to guide appropriate behavior in the use of electronic devices in the educational setting.

- 2. Policy Considerations.
 - a. The use of electronic devices in the classroom setting (i.e., laptop computers, tablets, smartphones/cellphones, smart watches, electronic eyewear, headphones (wired/wireless)) is to be limited to that which is necessary for that particular class.
 - b. Smart phones/Cell phones are to be turned off or placed in vibrate mode.
 - c. Unofficial recording by students (audio and videotaping) is prohibited. Any violation of this policy will be considered unprofessional conduct.
