Goals:

- 1. Achieve knowledge in pharmacology, indications, administration methods, and toxicities and management of systemic agents used in the practice of hematology and oncology.
- 2. Learn about supportive care for hematology-oncology patient and their families.
- 3. Teach and supervise the residents, interns and nurses about leukemia/lymphoma.
- 4. Get familiar with bone marrow biopsy technique and interpretation.

Objectives:

- 1. Be on call for problems and procedures (paracentesis, lumbar punctures, thoracentesis, etc) in the chemotherapy room.
- 2. Assess patients presenting as walk-in with acute problem.
- 3. Perfom bone marrow biopsies and get familiar with reading bone marrow biopsy.
