Other important information related to joining the TTUHSC School of Medicine community:

- 1. **Prior to MS 1 orientation (by July 21st)**, you are expected to complete several required online training modules. Follow the instructions provided for each set of required trainings:
  - HIPAA Privacy and Security Training
  - Title IX Training
  - Safety Training Education for Students (STEPS)
  - Lab Safety Essentials (LSE) 1 & 2
- 2. For the protection of our TTUHSC health care personnel and patients the School of Medicine has adopted a <u>Blood Borne Pathogen Infection Policy for Medical Students</u>. Please be familiar with this policy upon entry into the School of Medicine. If you have any questions regarding the Blood Borne Pathogen Infection Policy for Medical Students, please contact the School of Medicine Office of Student Affairs.
- 3. Class of 2029 MS 1 orientation will be in person. The current dates for MS 1 orientation are July 23<sup>rd</sup> July 25<sup>th</sup>. Attendance at MS 1 orientation activities is mandatory for all incoming students. Details regarding MS 1 orientation will be made available to the class in a second communication you will receive from our office in July. The Phase 1 curriculum officially starts Monday, July 28<sup>th</sup>. All Class of 2029 students are expected to be present in Lubbock for the start of the Phase 1 curriculum.
- 4. It is your responsibility to keep us informed of any contact information changes by emailing <a href="mailto:jennifer.acevedo@ttuhsc.edu">jennifer.acevedo@ttuhsc.edu</a> to ensure you are receiving timely communication from us that is necessary prior to your matriculation.
- 5. If you choose to purchase a home in Lubbock, please be mindful that purchasing a house in Lubbock after receiving your acceptance to the School of Medicine **does not** impact assignment to a Lubbock based clinical campus.
- 6. The pre-clinical/Phase 1 curriculum will begin in late July 2025 and conclude for Class of 2029 in late March early April 2027. Students relocating to a regional clinical campus in Amarillo or Odessa may elect to move in March or April 2027. For those who enter a Lubbock based rental agreement for housing while completing Phase 1, be aware of how your initial lease agreement or renewal is structured to avoid incurring fees due to moving out of Lubbock in Spring 2027.
