During her free time, she enjoys bowling and spending time with her friends and family.

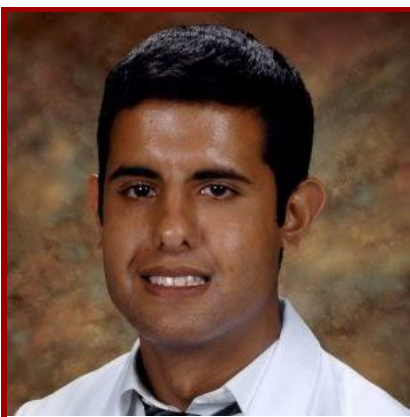

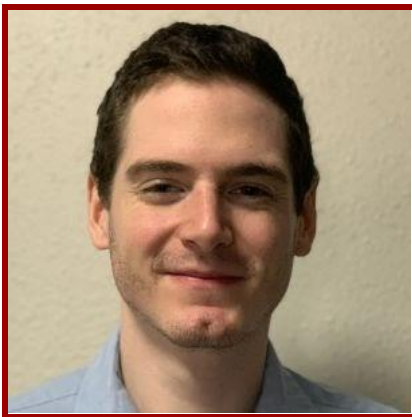
