Revised Senate Representation**

Whereas, the purpose of the TTUHSC Student Senate is to represent the voices of all students equally, regardless of school or program,

Whereas, representation for each school, department, and class is determined by the number of students in each respective division,

Whereas, current representation on the TTUHSC Senate is based on multiples of 25,

Whereas, our Senate passed a resolution on September 30, 2002, stating that “the TTUHSC Senate supports the establishment of a minimum of 25 students per program for Senate representation,”

Whereas, enrollment numbers have changed and the current Senate representation is not equally distributed among schools at the HSC,

Therefore, be it resolved that the TTUHSC Student Senate supports an amendment to Section I of the TTUHSC Student Senate By-Laws by replacing the current senate representation with the new representation as indicated on the “Revised Senate Representation” attachment.
